This Show is a qualifier for the BSPS Roger's Truck Services Ltd and B.S.P.S. Summer Championship Show.

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS, are subject to the Rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures, and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS. Riders in the BSPS classes must adhere to rule 43 in the 2023 rulebook with regard to hat specification and tagging.

This Show is a qualifier for the RIHS. Only one pony in each of the Pretty Polly Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden, Pretty Polly Heritage Mixed Breeds Ridden or Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden, Open Heritage Ridden or the Anglo and Part Bred classes qualifies and the highest placed (not already qualified) from the first THREE ponies placed in each class will qualify. Owners and riders must be B.S.P.S. members before the date of the show to qualify in classes with qualification for RIHS (including Pretty Polly and Heritage qualifying classes) and animals must be registered with the B.S.P.S. except for Anglo and Part Bred Arabs who must be registered with the AHS. Membership forms and payments must be received in the BSPS office no later than the last working day (Monday to Friday) prior to the date of the qualifying show.

NPS GENERAL RULES –

All NPS affiliated classes are judged under NPS rules. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by non-members, but only ponies owned by adult Qualifying or Life NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition.

The highest placed pony owned by a NPS members in each class go forward to the final. Qualification may go no further than 3rd Place.

Silver Medal Rosettes can only be won by ponies owned by NPS Qualifying or Life Members.

NPS Qualifying Rounds:

NPS Qualifying Rounds: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in any of the British Riding Pony studbook sections or the Ridden Register; the GSB; the AHSB; the AASB or registered in the main body of their respective M&M Stud Book. Part Breds are not eligible unless over stamped into one of the British Riding Pony studbook sections. or the Ridden Register. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 1st– 3rd August 2023. The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified. NPS/Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards MUST be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette, but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show 1st – 3rd August 2023.

13. All ponies exhibited in the Mountain & Moorland classes must be registered with their appropriate Breed Society and entered in the name under which they have been registered.
14. Riders of small breeds stallions (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh Sections A & B) must have attained their 12th birthday before 1st January of the current year. Riders of large breeds stallions (Highland, Dales, Fell, New Forest, Connemara, Welsh Sections C & D) must have attained their 14th birthday by 1st January of the current year.
15. All ridden Mountain & Moorland ponies must be four years or over.
16. In NPS affiliated classes all foals must be at least four weeks old on the day of the show and must accompany their dam into the ring and be led alongside the mare as much as possible.
17. All dogs should be kept on leads while on the showground.
18. **EXHIBITORS SHOULD ENSURE THAT THEY ARE ADEQUATELY COVERED BY THIRD PARTY INSURANCE.**
19. Handlers of ponies in in-hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured current British Standard skull caps / riding hats.
20. All NPS and BSPS affiliated classes will be run in accordance with current NPS and BSPS rules.
21. The Bronze Medal Status of the show will be verified by the WPCS after the event and if the requirements of the WPCS rules are met, the society will issue the correct awards. Any Questions relating to the status of the show must be made direct to the WPCS office. Enquiries@wpcs.uk.com
22. The Champion and Reserve Champions in each of the Welsh In Hand sections may be eligible for a Welsh Pony and Cob Society Medal. The Medal will be awarded to the highest placed registered pony in each section not already in receipt of a Medal in the current year and shown by a paid up member of the Society.
