- 7. Best rider 17 years and over.
- 8. Best new combination.

#### **Start Time 12pm**

Judge: Miss K. Williams

- 9. Best Lead Rein pony, plaited or unplaited. Rider 9 or under on 1st January 2024.
- 10. Best First Ridden pony, plaited or unplaited. Rider 12 or under on 1st January 2024.
- 11. Assisted Ridden class, open to competitors who requires reassurance from one handler.
- 12. Walk and trot class. Open to any age or breed.
- 13. Best ridden pony under 138 cm, plaited or unplaited.
- 14. Best ridden horse or pony over 138cm plaited or unplaited.
- 15. Best in hand pony under 138cm plaited or unplaited.
- 16. Best in hand horse or pony over 138cm.
- 17. Best ridden pony not to have won a first prize on the day.
- 18. Pure ridden novice pony / horse any age, any height, to be ridden by a child / adult, never to have won a first prize at any show.

#### **GENERAL RULES**

- The Committee will not be held responsible for any accident arising from any cause connected with this show and it will be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Committee blameless and indemnify them from all legal proceedings.
- 2. The decision of the judges and Committee is final.
- 3. If a pony exceeds the height limit on the day, it may be transferred to another class at the discretion of the judge or Committee.
- 4. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be ready for the start of their class, and to fully know and abide by the rules for the class they are entering.
- 5. No spurs are to be worn in ridden classes.
- 6. All stallions and colts two years and over must be adequately bitted.
- 7. All stallions and colts two years and over must hold a current stallion licence, unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
- 8. Handlers of stallions and colts must have attained their 14th Birthday before 1st January of the current year.
- 9. Riders of small breeds stallions (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh Sections A & B) must have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year. Riders of large breeds stallions (Highland, Dales, Fell, New Forest, Connemara, Welsh Sections C & D) must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year.
- 10. All ridden Mountain & Moorland ponies must be four years or over.
- 11. EXHIBITORS SHOULD ENSURE THAT THEY ARE ADEQUATELY COVERED BY THIRD PARTY INSURANCE.
- 12. Handlers of ponies in in-hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured current British Standard skull caps / riding hats.
