Binks Family 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Show Champion of Champions, White Company 50<sup>th</sup> Year Golden Anniversary Mini WHP Champion of Champions

This Show is affiliated to the British Show Pony Society (BSPS) and all persons entering, competing, showing or otherwise taking part in BSPS classes, whether or not members of the BSPS, are subject to the constitution and rules of the BSPS, including the disciplinary procedures and shall be deemed to have consented to the jurisdiction of the BSPS.

***This Show is a qualifier for the RIHS.*** Only one pony in each of the Pretty Polly Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden, Pretty Polly Heritage Mixed Breeds Ridden or Open Heritage Lead Rein and First Ridden, Open Heritage Ridden, Nursery Stakes, Open WHP and Intermediate WHP Classes qualifiers and the highest placed (not already qualified) from the first 3 ponies placed in each class will

qualify. Owners and rider must be B.S.P.S. members and animals must be registered with the B.S.P.S., before the date of the show, to compete in classes with R.I.H.S. qualification.

### **NPS GENERAL RULES –**

All NPS affiliated classes are judged under NPS rules. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members, but only ponies owned by adult Qualifying or Life NPS members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition.

The highest placed pony owned by an NPS member in each class goes forward to the final. Qualification may go no further than 3<sup>rd</sup> Place.

Silver Medal Rosettes can only be won by ponies owned by NPS Qualifying or Life Members.

### **NPS Mountain and Moorland Qualifying Rounds:**

These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS.

Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Partbreds are not eligible. Qualifying rounds for most NPS competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS **Qualifying or Life** members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern.

**The highest placed pony, if owned by an NPS member, in each class will qualify for the final. Qualification may pass down to third place if the first and second ponies are already qualified.**

NPS/Rosettes Direct Home Produced Ridden Championship - Riders of Home Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. All qualifying ponies will receive a qualification card. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.

### **NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships**

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification

card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS.

The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships. Qualifiers are entitled to compete in the final of the Silver Medal Rosette Championship to be held at the NPS Summer Championship Show **6<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> August 2019.**

## **GENERAL RULES**

1. The Committee will not be held responsible for any accident arising from any cause connected with this show and it will be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the Committee blameless and indemnify them from all legal proceedings.
2. The decision of the judges and Committee is final.
3. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any classes with less than 3 entries or to amalgamate classes if insufficient entries are received.
4. In the event of the need for a referee judge that judge's decision will be taken as final.
5. If a pony exceeds the height limit on the day it may be transferred to another class at the discretion of the judge or Committee.
6. Whips / canes in any class must not exceed 75cm (30"). If misused, in the opinion of the judge, an exhibitor may be sent out of the ring and may also be reported to the NPS Disciplinary Committee.
7. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be ready for the start of their class, and to fully know and abide by the rules for the class they are entering.
8. No ponies are to be plaited in Mountain & Moorland classes.
9. No spurs are to be worn in ridden classes.
10. All stallions and colts two years and over must be adequately bitted.
11. All stallions and colts two years and over must hold a current stallion licence, unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
12. Handlers of stallions and colts must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> Birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year.
13. All ponies exhibited in the Mountain & Moorland classes must be registered with their appropriate Breed Society and entered in the name under which they have been registered.
14. Riders of small breeds stallions (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh Sections A & B) must have attained their 12<sup>th</sup> birthday before 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year. Riders of large breeds stallions (Highland, Dales, Fell, New Forest, Connemara, Welsh Sections C & D) must have attained their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday by 1<sup>st</sup> January of the current year.
15. All ridden Mountain & Moorland ponies must be four years or over.
16. In NPS affiliated classes all foals must be at least four weeks old on the day of the show and must accompany their dam into the ring and be led alongside the mare as much as possible.
17. All dogs should be kept on leads while on the showground.
18. **EXHIBITORS SHOULD ENSURE THAT THEY ARE ADEQUATELY COVERED BY THIRD PARTY INSURANCE.**
19. Handlers of ponies in in-hand classes aged 14 years and under must wear correctly secured current British Standard skull caps / riding hats.
20. All NPS and BSPS affiliated classes will be run in accordance with current NPS and BSPS rules.

The Champion and Reserve Champions in each of the Welsh In Hand sections may be eligible for a Welsh Pony and Cob Society Medal. The Medal will be awarded to the highest placed registered pony in each section not already in receipt of a Medal in the current year and shown by a paid up member of the Society.

### **From the West Country or M4 westbound**

- Leave M4 at Jct 21 (M48, signposted Chepstow and services)
- Cross the old Severn Bridge and immediately after bridge exit M48 Jct 2 (signposted Chepstow)
- At roundabout take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit on to A466
- At Highbeech Roundabout take 1<sup>st</sup> exit on to A48 Caerwent, passing St Pierre Golf Club after 1 mile
- At Parkwall Roundabout take 2<sup>nd</sup> exit and proceed downhill under bridge

## **Vaccination Requirements**

All animals entering the showground are required to have up to date equine influenza vaccinations and owners must bring their passports in order to prove this.

Detailed Vaccination requirements:

- An initial course of two injections for primary vaccination, not less than 21 days and not more than 92 days apart, are required before being eligible to compete;
- A first booster injection must be given between 150 and 215 days after the second injection of primary vaccination;
- Subsequent booster injections must be given at intervals of not more than one calendar year, commencing after the first booster injection. However, we would strongly recommend against attending an event more than six calendar months after the booster injection.
  - The full course or booster must have been administered at least seven days before the competition.
